Thank you for taking the time to voice your concerns regarding personnel at Cerritos Station. On April 3, 2003, you faxed a letter to Captain Ted Siara that you were denied filing a criminal report of forgery by Deputy Mark Smith. Our investigation revealed that the initial actions of Deputy Smith regarding this incident were reasonable and within established Department policy and guidelines. However, in the interest of providing the best possible service, given the complexities of real estate transactions and associated law a complaint report has been written and assigned to the Real Estate Fraud Unit for an expert determination.

I am concerned about the public confidence in the investigation of complaints against members of the Sheriff's Department. It is my sincere hope, that any future contact you have with the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department will be much more positive in nature.

I appreciate you bringing this matter to my attention and the opportunity it afforded me to evaluate the conduct of our personnel.
