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NARRATIVE:

On 12/3/00, at approximately 1416 hours, I was dispatched to 163 Streamwood, the Springs Condominiums, reference paint, which was poured on a rear gate at the location. Upon my arrival, I met with the victim, Sadegh Davari, who told me the following:

Davari lives in the condominium located at 163 Streamwood, in Irvine. He said he arrived home at 12/3/00, at approximately 0200 hours, and parked his vehicle in his assigned carport, #529. His carport faces the fence and gate, which enclose his rear patio. At that time, he said the wooden gate was clean, and there was no blue paint on the gate. Davari said he returned to his carport on 12/3/00, at approximately 1300 hours, and discovered blue paint splashed over most of the front, lower half of the gate. The gate opened from his carport area to his rear patio. Davari said he saw partial blue shoeprints, which started at his carport, near the blue paint, and ended at a vehicle parked in Carport #576.

✖ Davari said he does not know whom the vehicle in Carport #576 belonged to.

✖ Davari said over the past couple of months, he has called the police a couple of times due to excessive noise coming from his neighbor's condominium, 164 Streamwood, late at night. He said 164 Streamwood is located directly above his condominium. ✖ He said he does not know the name of the residents who live in 164 Streamwood, and has only seen them a couple of times. He said they have acted quite hostile towards him. He said he believes one female adult and one male adult live in the condominium above his. Davari said no one saw the suspects throw paint on his gate; however, he said he believed the residents in 164 Streamwood poured the paint on his gate because they were upset with him for calling the police.

I inspected Davari's gate. There was fresh blue paint slashed on the lower half of the gate, and it covered most of the lower half of the gate. The paint had dripped on the steps and the ground of the carport, directly below the gate. There was a small paint can located on the ground, next to the steps, which were directly below the gate. The paint can did not have a lid, and there was fresh blue paint inside the can. The paint in the can matched the paint on the gate. There were blue paint splotches, which appeared to be partial shoeprints, leading from the gate through Davari's carport and along the roadway. The partial shoeprints matched the blue paint on Davari's gate. I counted 23 partial shoeprints. I could not make out the size or shape of the shoe, as the prints were partial. The partial shoeprints ended on the ground, directly below the trunk

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of the vehicle which was parked in Carport #576. Carport #576 was located nine carports to the west of Davari's carport. The California license plate on the vehicle parked in #576 was 1MFX699. I ran that license plate, and it came back to a 1985 Chevrolet, registered to Michael Steven Laham, at 174 Streamwood, in Irvine.

Officer Allan and Officer Casas responded to my location because a couple weeks prior, they were on a car stop on Irvine Boulevard, just to the south of the Springs Condominiums. At that time, the female resident, at 164 Streamwood, could see Officer Allan and Officer Casas from a window in her condominium. Officer Allan and Officer Casas told me she was screaming profanities and rude comments to them as they completed their car stop. Officer Allan and Officer Casas attempted to make contact with the residents at 164 Streamwood; however, they did not answer the door.

I requested CSI, and Officer Beard responded. Officer Beard took several photographs of the gate, shoeprints, and the older model Chevrolet, 1MFX699, parked in Carport #576. Officer Beard collected the paint can for fingerprinting and booked it into the Property Department as evidence.

I gave Davari my business card with this report number on it.

Narrative:

On 12-3-00 at approximately 1445 hours, I was dispatched to 163 Streamwood to take CSI photos of damage sustained in vandalism. Upon my arrival, I met with CSO Lisa Miller, who explained the circumstances of the crime.

Miller directed me to a fence at the back of 163 Streamwood located adjacent to carport space # 529. The suspect tossed blue paint onto the fence, and the near empty paint can and lid was left lying below. Shoe prints made by paint on the soles were found on the pavement leading from the crime scene westbound down the drive and ended next to a blue Chevrolet four door, license 1MFX699/CA. The car was parked in carport space #576.

I took a series of seventeen digital photos of the crime scene, which included photos of the fence, the paint can, shoe prints, and the car that the shoe prints led to. Photos of the shoe prints were taken with and without a photo scale. The shoe print measured approximately 10.5 inches. A partial pattern was present and appears to be from a tennis shoe. Outside the driver's door of the blue Chevrolet was a partial shoe print not laid in paint. The pattern was also from a tennis shoe, which I took a photo of.

I collected the paint can and transported it to IPD where I secured it in the CSI lab pending processing for latent prints. On 12-4-00 at approximately 1015 hours, I processed the can using Superglue fuming. Some latent print impressions were present on the bottom of the can, but there was no sufficient ridge detail to use for comparison. The can was disposed of since it was of no further evidentiary use.

The digital photos were downloaded into the IPD photo network file. A contact sheet of the photos is attached.
