## NARRATIVE:



On 2/12/01, at 1856 hours, I was dispatched to 155 Streamwood in reference to a vandalism report. Upon arrival, I contacted the reporting party, Kathryn Morrell, who told me the following.

Morrell said that she wanted to make a vandalism report in regards to her front screen door which had been "slashed." She said unknown suspect(s) damaged the screen some time during the night on 2/8/01 (Thursday) and 2/9/01 (Friday) between the hours of 1730 and 0700. Morrell showed me the screen door and I could see a 24 inch horizontal cut in the middle of the screen.

Morrell said on 2/4/01, at approximately 1730 hours, she discovered that her garden hose had been "severed." She was unsure exactly when the hose was cut.

Morrell did not immediately notify the police regarding these two occurrences of vandalism because no suspects were seen or heard. On this date, Morrell decided to contact the police to report these incidences because of ongoing problems she has had with her neighbors who live directly across from her in condo #164. She said other neighbors have had ongoing problems with these residents. She believes the male resident, later identified as Steven Laham, was responsible for the vandalism to her vehicle. This vandalism was reported on 4/24/00 to the Irvine Police Department under DR 00-7755. Morrell also said on the morning of 2/9/01 (Friday) an anonymous neighbor found on Morrell's car a typed 8 1/2" sheet of white paper that stated, "I'd rather be fat and nice than a two-faced anorexic bitch of ice. Response to your letter." The neighbor collected this off Morrell's vehicle and later gave it to her. Morrell said several months prior, she had written a letter to the neighbors at 164 in an effort to smooth things over with them. Morrell stated in the letter that she wanted to peacefully coexist with them since they were neighbors. So far, the letter has not worked as is evidence of this note that was left on her vehicle.

Morrell requested that I not make contact with Laham or his wife because she feels that this would only cause future problems. She only wanted this incident documented in case of future problems or acts of vandalism.
