### 594(a)(2) CPC Vandalism to a Vehicle

On 9-30-01, at approximately 0907 hours, I was dispatched to 163 Streamwood reference vandalism to a vehicle. Upon my arrival I contacted Davari, He stated that he parked his vehicle in his assigned slot at approximately 0130 on 9-29-01. He saw the car again at approximately 2000 hours on 9-29-01 when he walked a friend out to her vehicle. There was no damage to the vehicle at that time.

At approximately 0850 on 9-30-01, Davari was notified by his neighbor (B.J. Ashman, 1-10-41) about damage to his vehicle. He went down to the parking lot and saw the paint peeling off the vehicle. He then called 911 and waited outside for our arrival.

When I looked at the car I could see a large area of paint peeling off of the trunk, tail light, and rear bumper of the vehicle. There were also marks on the base of the back window from the liquid. It appears that the suspect(s) poured paint thinner or a similar substance on the back of the vehicle, near the bottom of the window. It looks like the liquid then ran down the window and over the trunk. It then ran off the trunk onto the rear taillight and bumper.

The area of paint affected on the trunk is approximately 25 inches wide by 22 inches long. The liquid fell onto the rear taillight affecting approximately 3 to 4 inches of the left light. The area affected on the bumper was approximately 21 inches wide by 5 inches long. The remaining portion of the liquid ran off the bumper and onto the cement parking lot.

I then spoke with Ashman. She stated that she saw the damage at on 9-30-01, approximately 0830 hours. She just happened to walk by it while walking her dog. As soon as she saw it, she went and notified Davari. She did not see anyone commit the act or around the vehicle.

Davari believes the suspect are his upstairs neighbors, Michael and Elana Laham. Davari stated that they have had numerous problems with them in the past. Davari does not believe this is due to a specific incident. He thinks it is just due to the incidents that have occurred between them in the last 4 months. He did not have any details that were more specific.

I attempted to contact the suspects by going to their residence and by telephone. Both methods were unsuccessful.

CSI Wrightman came to the scene and took 35mm photos of the vehicle.
