

**Unlawful harassment** means a knowing and willful course of conduct directed at a specific person which seriously alarms, annoys, or harasses, or is detrimental to such person and which serves no legitimate or lawful purpose. The course of conduct shall be such as would cause a reasonable person to suffer substantial emotional distress and shall actually cause substantial emotional distress to the petitioner or when the course of conduct would cause a reasonable parent to fear for the well-being of their child. Course of conduct means a pattern of conduct composed of a series of acts over a period of time, however short, evidencing a continuity of purpose. "Course of conduct" includes, in addition to any other form of communication, contact, or conduct, the sending of an electronic communication. Constitutionally protected activities, including free speech, are not included within the meaning of "course of conduct."

I met Elana for the 1st time on Aug <sup>11<sup>th</sup></sup> 2011 - she was a new patient in my office. Her husband Michael Laham accompanied her. She came in to see me for a minor, non-life threatening skin rash that was already improving. I gave them my opinion on the diagnosis and treatment options for the rash, but they didn't believe me and became angry and combative. Elana grabbed a paper sheet she had got up into my face (~6 in away) and started reading some scripture-like quote? - I was in shock. She & Michael stormed out of my office. As Michael exited my waiting room he shouted: "let's BLOW this joint" in front of other patients and my office staff.

The content & sense of hatred assoc. with the voicemail & mult FAX's makes me worry about my safety, the safety of my family, the safety of my office staff. My staff has expressed concern about coming into work worrying the Lahams may show up. I have a small staff of 7 women.
