The reason why we have elected to close out our checking account #101016525, which averaged a balance of \$20,000.00, is because of the following reason:

The following six checks cleared our checking account without any information on the back of them indicating the bank and/or bank account they were to get deposited into:

The only number on the back of five of these checks was the number "20000 3103 9297". The other check had nothing written on the back of it. We therefore requested that Fife Commercial Bank send us in writing the account number and the routing number or the name of the bank into which the money was being deposited.

Bank Teller Mary Kay, agreed with us that it was "weird" that these checks were being processed, cleared, and paid upon. She then told us that the above number was the check holder's bank account and that it was being deposited into Wachovia Bank.

But later on, when we told her that we NEVER had a check presented to our bank that did not have both a bank account and either routing number or a bank stamp on it, Mary Kay's response was that Wachovia Bank does not put its routing number or stamp on the checks that get deposited into it. And what about the one check that had neither a routing number nor a bank account number on it? Why did that get processed?

We do not appreciate being LIED to. Whom was Mary Kay trying to protect? We are the customer who gives you all a job, especially in this bad economy. Therefore we will not be doing any further business with Fife Commercial Bank. Please refrain from sending us any correspondence as it will not be read, opened, or listened to, and will either be trashed or returned to sender.
