

Did you know you can opt out of showing up in the <u>featured snippets box</u>, you know the box at the top where Google takes more content from the site to answer the query sooner? They look like this:



You can ensure your site does not show up in that featured snippet box by adding the to your page.

This was posted in the <u>SitePoint Forums</u> back in February, but I missed it until I saw <u>the new</u> "about this result" link that takes you to <u>this page</u> on Google.

On that page, it shares how to opt out of showing up there.

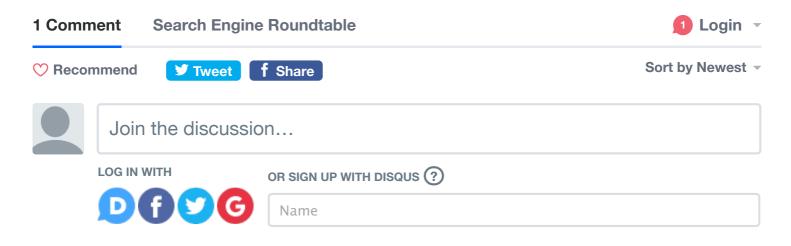
I know many of you wanted a way to ensure Google can't do that to your site but will you add it? I mean, Google might put another site in that box instead of yours...

Some asked that I clarify the obvious: Adding the nosnippet tag to your page will not just remove you from the featured snippet section but also remove your snippets (hence nosnippet) from the main search results.
